Please note:

- It will be your responsibility to keep your login details and password safe and secure. If you know or suspect that your record has been accessed by someone that you have not agreed should see it, then you should change your password immediately.

- The practice may not be able to offer online access due to a number of reasons, such as concerns that it could cause harm to physical or mental health, or where there is reference to third parties. The practice has the right to remove access to online services for anyone that doesn't use them responsibly.
- If you think you may be pressured into revealing details from your patient record to someone else against your will, it is best that you do not register for access at this time.
- It's up to you whether you share your information with others – perhaps family members or carers. It's your choice, but also your responsibility to keep the information safe and secure.
